Looking ahead to the 2025 legislative session, we will continue advocating for critical initiatives, including 100% state funding for State Sponsored Life Insurance base death benefit premiums for all currently serving Soldiers and Airmen, a return to pre-2011 education benefits for dependents of disabled veterans, and fee remission for veterans at all Indiana State Parks.

We extend our deepest gratitude to the volunteers who serve on our Board of Directors. Through their selfless dedication, they bring invaluable time and talents to furthering our mission: promoting the growth and development of the Indiana Army and Air National Guard, fostering camaraderie among the Guard's officer and enlisted personnel, and enhancing the quality of life for our members and their families.
